Report Highlights: Sugar consumption has not been surveyed in Bosnia Herzegovina (BiH) since 1990 but it is estimated to be around 35 kg per capita. The population is 3.8 million and thus total estimated sugar consumption is 133,000 MT. Sugar production is zero. Official import data are unreliable. Exports are minor. Stocks are estimated to be around 20,000MT.

Sugar consumption has not been surveyed in Bosnia Herzegovina (BiH) since 1990 but it is estimated to be around 35 kg per capita. The population is 3.8 million and thus total estimated sugar consumption is 133,000 MT.

Sugar production is zero. There is one sugar refinery in Bijeljina but it is not operating. There has been a recent recovery in the food processing sector and an increase in demand from this sector is likely in the coming years.

Official import data are unreliable. Exports are minor. Stocks are estimated to be around 20,000MT.
